Day 1: MONDAY 24 SEPTEMBER 2018 - FLOUR MILLS OF THE ADELAIDE HILLS - Departs 9.15am

Join members of the Adelaide Hills Motor Restorers Club for a drive in the Adelaide Hills to their clubrooms for Morning Tea. Then tour past several old Flour Mills finishing at the Bridgewater Mill with its turning waterwheel. Lunch can be purchased at Bridgewater Inn Hotel (optional) or BYO. Limited to 50 vehicles.

Day 8: MONDAY 1 OCTOBER 2018 - WHEELS AND TRACKS - Departs 9.30am

We invite you on a run of approximately 40 kilometres to visit the National Military Vehicle Museum at Edinburgh Park.

The 6 acre site with onsite parking is a group of heritage listed buildings built during World War 2 which now house an extensive collection of historic military vehicles dating back to 1916. On display is "Miss Stuart" an operational 1942 American M3 Tank powered by a 250 HP radial aircraft engine and more than 60 other vehicles and equipment depicting the contribution of automotive manufacturers to the Australian Military Forces. Dioramas and displays of memorabilia depict Australians in past conflicts and peace keeping roles.

On arrival tea and coffee will be provided. There will be a guided tour of the Museum followed by a BBQ lunch with dessert at the Museums all weather eating area.

In the afternoon there will be a tour of the Restoration Workshop then the volunteers will demonstrate the capabilities of "Miss Stuart" and other vehicles on the Museum testing area. For the more adventurous there is the opportunity to ride in the vehicles.

Day 9 TUESDAY 2 OCTOBER 2018 - JEWELS OF THE FLEURIEU SOUTH COAST Departs 9.15am

The Historic Motor Vehicle Club and its members invite you to join them on a visit to Victor Harbor. Leaving Motorfest Headquarters at 9.15am the HMVC will lead the way through southern scenery to a Museum and Mystery Shed of car collection and automobelia. Afterwards visiting rugged coastal scenery on the way to lunch at Middleton Tavern. These southern tours are always popular, so we have limited bookings to 50 people for catering purposes.

Day 10 WEDNESDAY 3 OCTOBER 2018 - DROUGHT PROOFING ADELAIDE - Departs 9.30am

The Vintage Sports Car Club of South Australia invites you to inspect Adelaide's waterworks. Commencing at Motorfest Headquarters we travel south to the Filtration Plant at Happy Valley, before lunching at a near country hotel. Day 12 FRIDAY 5 OCTOBER 2018 - THE PAECH'S NOSTALGIC FARM Departs 9.00am

A relaxing day on a farm full of nostalgia starts by departing from Motorfest Headquarters at 9.00am and driving mostly on minor roads. We head up to Mt Barker in the Adelaide Hills via "The Old Princes Highway" which was once the main thoroughfare prior to the South Eastern Freeway. Passing through picturesque Stirling and Aldgate and on through historical Hahndorf, still on the "old road" we go through Mt Barker into Paech's Farm at Wistow.

On arrival we will enjoy a Devonshire tea, followed by a talk on the farm's history. The farm is still in the Paech family after 4 generations and hence has a large amount of historical items.

Along with tools, working exhibits, local farmers items, tractors and implements for the boys, there is the home, some of it still original. Inside there is the original kitchen utensils, 1900's hand made gowns, jewellery and much more, including the picturesque garden. There is free time to look around all the displays before a barbecue and salad lunch.
