

## Awards

A \$50 fee applies to enter the Concours d'Elegance and Preservation awards of the Bay to Birdwood.

As an entrant for the awards you have agreed to compete in the spirit of the categories. We have prepared some basic rules and guidelines to assist you.

- \* All vehicles must comply with the conditions of entry.
- \* At least three photos which clearly display your vehicle as it will be shown on the day must be submitted with your entry form. Visit the website for further clarification on this. (see samples below)
- \* Vehicles must be presented for judging at the National Motor Museum, Birdwood in the allocated judging area. Drivers/riders must stay with their vehicle until judging is completed. (approximately 12.30pm)
- \* Shortlisted finalists may be asked to relocate their vehicles to a display area at some point after judging is completed.
- \* There will be a stage presentation to the winner of each award.
- \* Vehicles arriving at the finish site after midday may not be able to be judged and may be declared ineligible.
- \* As entrants of awards your vehicle must be presented in a suitable condition for competition.
- \* Refer to the FAQ guide on the website for more information.
- \* If you decide to withdraw from the awards for any reason, please advise the Organisers as soon as possible to avoid any confusion on the day. Refunds of award category fees are not available.

Judging will be undertaken by an expert panel.

## Concours d'Elegance

The Concours d'Elegance Trophy is the most prestigious award presented at the Bay to Birdwood. It has been won by some of the finest historic vehicles in Australia.

It is worth noting that the Bay to Birdwood Concours d'Elegance allocates **points for period-correct clothing, so suitable attire related to the era of your vehicle must be worn** to be considered as a Concours d'Elegance entrant.

### SUITABLE CONDITION

- means a well presented and detailed vehicle. It does not mean faded paint, ripped, torn or badly worn interior or vehicles in a overall poor condition. Minor modifications aimed at ensuring roadworthiness and safety of the vehicle (eg electric starters, seatbelts) are permitted.

## Preservation Class

Introduced in 2016, the Preservation award is for vehicles that have not been substantially restored or modified. The interest in untouched and largely preserved vehicles has been growing within the historic motor vehicle movement for many years. The Bay to Birdwood acknowledges this interest with this award. Please note that while entrants are encouraged to wear suitable period-correct attire when accompanying their vehicles. **NO judging points are awarded for attire in this award category.**

### SUITABLE CONDITION

- means a well presented vehicle without restoration or significant modification.

**Entries for the Preservation Class award will be scrutineered more strictly in 2019. Vehicles which have had significant intervention will be denied entry.**

The overall condition of the vehicle must be substantially unaltered from original delivery, but may show signs of sympathetic use. Minor modifications aimed at ensuring roadworthiness and safety of the vehicle (eg electric starters, seatbelts) are permitted.

### Please take note of the rule regarding previous winners.

- \* Any vehicle that wins an award will NOT be eligible to win or enter the award section for the next ten consecutive Bay to Birdwood Run events.
- \* Previous winning vehicles are encouraged to enter the event and will be displayed with other previous award winning vehicles. Please contact the Organisers if you are entering a Bay to Birdwood award winning vehicle.

## The Event

The Bay to Birdwood is one of the world's great historic motoring events. It was first held in 1980 and was a biennial event undertaken in even numbered years focused on pre-WWII vehicles. This date range focus has changed over time and the 'Run' – still held in even numbered years - is currently focused on veteran, vintage and early-classic vehicles manufactured up to December 1956. The 2019 Bay to Birdwood Classic is a one-day event for vehicles manufactured from 1956 to 1986 and will be held on Sunday 29 September 2019.

Starting from Adelaide Shores, West Beach, the event follows a route through metropolitan Adelaide, to the finish at the National Motor Museum, Birdwood.

**An alternate start location at Civic Park, Modbury is available (refer Alternate Start flyer for details).**

The Bay to Birdwood is a mass-participatory citizen-collector based historic motoring event. It draws participants from far and wide, attracts thousands of spectators to line the route and attend the start and finish events. Breakfast is available early at the start sites and then the passing parade is greeted by the many thousands that gather along the route to the finish at the Adelaide Hills township of Birdwood. At the finish there is entertainment, local produce, food and wine, children's activities and the camaraderie of participating in and celebrating this internationally renowned event. The judging of the vehicle awards takes place at the finish as well as Fashions in the Field - where participants have the opportunity to show off their finery and a chance to win great prizes.

**General public** are welcome to enjoy the start at no cost. Tickets for the finish event will be available online or can be purchased on the day at the National Motor Museum.

### AWARDS

The 2019 Bay to Birdwood Classic features two awards: the Concours d'Elegance and the Preservation. For more information refer to the descriptions and regulations on page 4.

### MOTORFEST

Taking place in the week before and the week after the Bay to Birdwood, Motorfest promises a memorable 11-day program of daily motoring activities that extends the Bay to Birdwood experience. For further details head to our website.

### Please note

A **NO ANIMALS** and **NO GLASS** policy applies at the start and finish event sites.

Entrants are advised that SA Police will pay particular attention to breaches of the road rules during the Bay to Birdwood, especially those referring to the carriage of passengers and children and the wearing of safety helmets.

Documentation will be forwarded in the first week of September 2019 to the address you have provided on the entry form. If this address is not suitable due to travel arrangements etc. please advise an alternative at the time of entering or before the second week of August.

# Conditions of Entry

## For the 2019 Bay to Birdwood Classic held on Sunday September 29

To assist with the smooth running of the event on the day, the following Rules and Conditions have been set. By signing the Entry Form you have understood and agreed to be bound by these Conditions.

- 1 The Entry Form must be signed by the owner of the motor vehicle.**
- 2 Only motor vehicles manufactured between 1956 to 1986 are eligible.**
- 3 All motor vehicles must be of a roadworthy standard in South Australia and of an acceptable standard of quality in the opinion of the Organisers.**
- 4 The onus of proof of date of manufacture is the entrant's responsibility. If required by the Organisers such proof must be substantiated and be supported by a Statutory Declaration. In the event of false information being supplied, the vehicle and entrant will be disqualified from the event and all entry fees forfeited.**
- 5 All motor vehicles must be registered or on permit inc trade plates.**
- 6 All motor vehicles must be driven/ridden by a licensed driver/rider who shall comply with the provisions of the Motor Vehicles Act 1959, as amended.**
- 7 Trailering or towing of any entrant vehicle from the start to the finish will result in disqualification. In circumstances such as breakdown, it will be acceptable for a vehicle to be brought to the finish but it will not be considered to have 'completed' the 2019 Bay to Birdwood Classic.**
- 8 All entrants will observe the current road laws and speed limits along the route, in particular those rules referring to the correct carriage of passengers and the wearing of approved motorcycle safety helmets.**
- 9 Entrants and passengers are subject to the directions and control of the Organisers of the event, their agents and authorized officers.**
- 10 The closing date for early bird entries is Friday 19 August 2019.**
- 11 The 2019 event is limited to 1750 vehicles. Should this number be reached at anytime leading up to the event, entries will be closed.**
- 12**
  - a** Payment of entry fees is accepted by cheque or money order made payable to the National Motor Museum. Payment may also be made by Credit Card and EFT.
  - b** Any payment received in excess of the prescribed entry fee will be treated as a donation.
  - c** Any refund, less 10% administration cost, will be made solely at the discretion of the Organisers.
  - d** Entry fees will not be returned for withdrawal of entries after 19 August 2019. Any rejected entries will have their fees refunded.
  - e** Entries received after 19 August closing date will incur an additional fee of \$15.

- 13 All entrants must supply a photograph of their vehicle** (a three-quarter view from the front) with their entry form as shown in the example below. This must be of the vehicle as it will be presented on the day of the event. Additional photographs may be requested for scrutineering purposes. For more information please refer to the Bay to Birdwood website baytobirdwood.com.au.
- 14** The decision of the Organisers on whether a vehicle is eligible or not shall be binding and final.
- 15** No substitution of vehicles will be allowed except under the following conditions:
  - a** The substitute motor vehicle must conform with the requirements of the conditions of entry;
  - b** The substitution shall be made with the knowledge and approval of the Organisers and may incur additional fees.
- 16** The Organisers reserve the right to reject or cancel any entry at any time and for any reason.
- 17** Entry numbers must be displayed on the motor vehicles to which they have been assigned.
- 18** Entrants will only be eligible to receive a plaque if they commence from the official start and complete the scheduled route to Birdwood on/in their motor vehicle and arrive at the finish before 4.00pm on Sunday 29 September 2019.
- 19** By entering the event participants authorise the Organisers to photograph, film or reproduce in any medium the vehicles used in the event and their occupants. Entrants hereby acknowledge that the Organisers shall have the free and unrestricted right to use entrants' names and/or such reproductions in the advertising and promotion of the event and future events.
- 20** A NO ANIMALS, NO GLASS policy will be enforced at the start and finish sites.
- 21** Entrants conducting themselves in a dangerous manner, or in a manner likely to bring the Bay to Birdwood event and its Organisers into disrepute, shall be disqualified immediately.
- 22** Towing of a caravan or boat is only permitted if it is of the period and approval is given by the Organisers.
- 23** The Organisers reserve the right to amend or add to these Rules anytime.



All entrants must supply a 3/4 view photo of their vehicle.
